His program opened with a tour of some of the historical sites in the Boston area. As members looked at images, Michael shared stories about the Freedom Trail, old State House, Faneuil Hall, USS Constitution, and the Boston Tea Party. The next stop was Seal Island. Seal Island is a National Wildlife Refuge. It is located off the coast of Rockland Maine. There are numerous nesting seabirds there such as razorbills, and Atlantic puffins. Michael explained the challenge of photographing the puffins because of their black and white coloring. He talked about the importance of bracketing and focus.

Michael captured some amazing images of the puffins and razorbills. There was one image of an artic tern which caught everyone's attention. While viewing the images we learned how to adjust the camera to photograph birds when their wings were flapping. It was inspiring to have the opportunity to see a puffin's character
