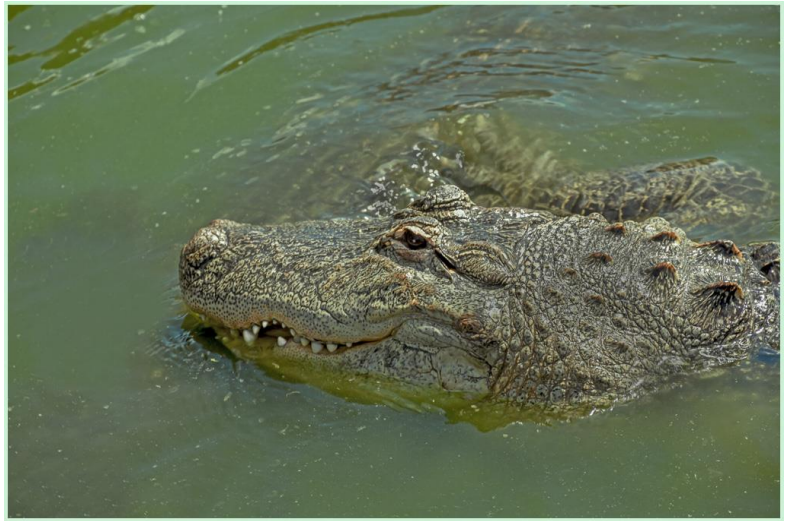
Members learned about the importance of use of the histogram and many other features on the camera.

The Shutterbugs thank Bob for his informative program.

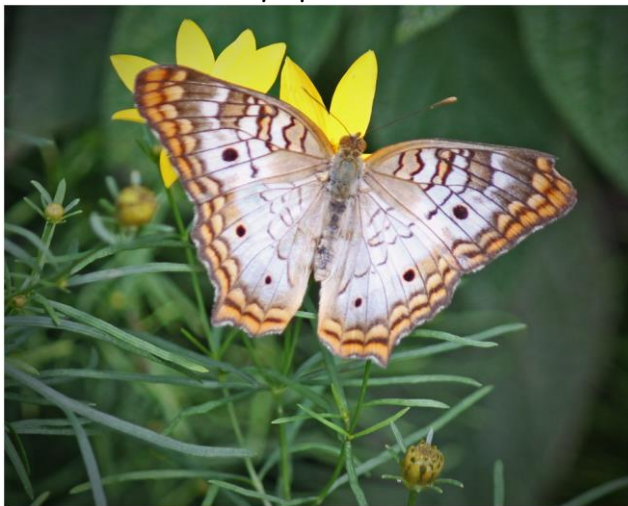

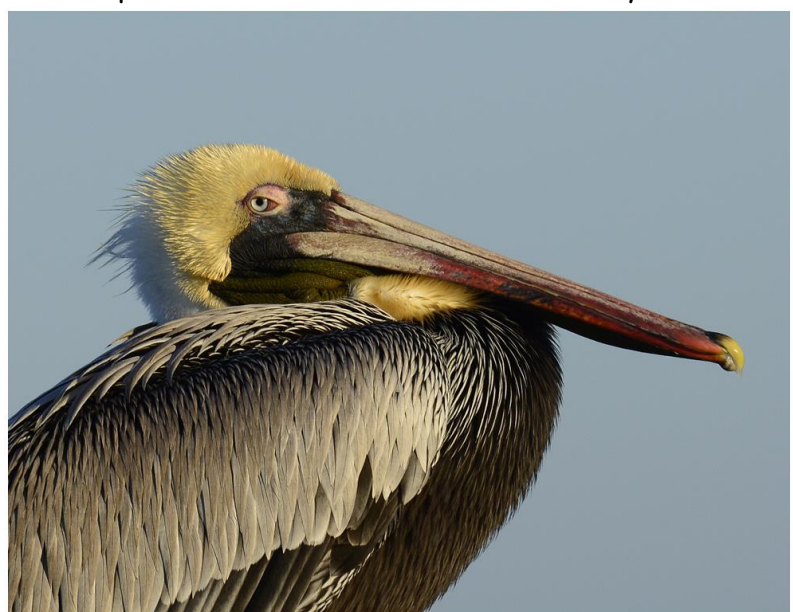
